UK Rare Diseases Framework and Action Plans

The UK Rare Diseases Framework was published in January 2021. This document outlines the governments' 4 priorities for improving care for people living with rare conditions to be implemented over 5 years (2021-2026).

Following engagement with various stakeholder groups including people living with a wide range of rare conditions and their families, the Framework identifies 4 priorities and 5 underpinning themes.

The 4 priorities are:



helping patients get a final diagnosis faster



better coordination of care

increasing awareness among healthcare professionals



improving access to specialist care, treatment and drugs

The 5 underpinning themes are:

- patient voice
- national and international collaboration
- pioneering research
- digital, data and technology
- wider policy alignment



England launched their action plan in February 2022 with updates in February 2023 and 2024. Northern Ireland launched their plan in March 2022. Wales launched in June 2022 with an update in January 2024. Scotland launched their action plan on 19 December 2022.
